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Personal skills and competences

Clinical and scientific activities have been particularly dedicated to **Surgical Oncology**; the knowledge of surgical techniques has been combined with modern concepts in the fields of oncology, radiotherapy and molecular biology focused on the multidisciplinary approach. Particular attention has been dedicated to gastric cancer, as Tuscany is a high-risk area for this neoplasm.

Studies on serological or tissue tumor markers, extended lymphadenectomy, prognostic factors and translational research for gastric cancer are particularly relevant. Statistical predictive models for gastric cancer are now used in several Italian and European Centers.

Funding member of the Italian Research Group for Gastric Cancer (GIRCG), which now includes several centers specialized in gastric cancer surgery. From 2006 has the role of the Scientific Secretary of the group, coordination of about 60 multicenter research studies, published on international journals. In 2017, he coordinated the "GIRCG Guidelines for gastric cancer staging and treatment-2015", published on *Gastric Cancer*.

Active collaboration with other international research groups: IPATIMUP (Porto), University of Munich, University of Seoul, University of San Paolo.

Particular attention has been also given to the use of advanced techniques in Surgical Oncology, as cytoreductive surgery, peritonectomy and locoregional treatments (HIPEC, PIPAC), as well as surgical treatment of colorectal, liver and pancreatic cancer.

About 3.000 operations performed to date, most of which as first operator in major surgical oncology, both open and minimally invasive (laparoscopic, robotics).
